- 90% of parents/caregivers will communicate with the school: reasons for student absences

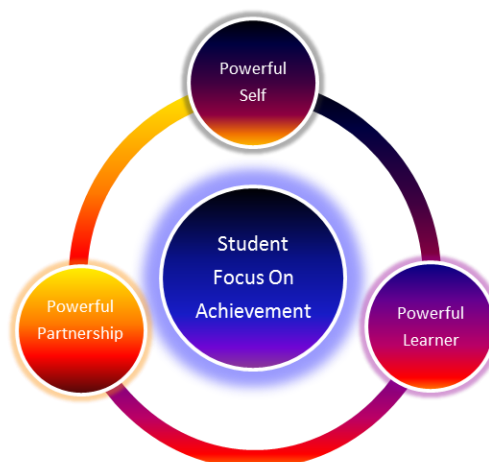
Staff Partnerships

NAPLAN

- 90 % Wave 1 and 2 students: at or above appropriate Proficiency Band

PATM

- 45% of students will achieve SEA Scale Score for their assigned level

Literacy-Improvement and Maintenance

NAPLAN

- 90% Wave 1 and 2 students: at or above appropriate Proficiency Band

Running Records (R-3)

- 94% of wave 1 and 2 students will achieve at or above year level SEA

Running Records (Yr 4-7)

- 65% of wave 1 and 2 students will achieve at or above year level standard
