#### **NAPLAN**

NAPLAN Testing will take place in week 3 next term. Students in Year 3, 5 and 7 will be participating in tests which will be administered Australia wide and provides information to families and schools about students' learning. NAPLAN tests the sorts of skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life, such as reading, writing, spelling, grammar and numeracy. It is important to remember that NAPLAN is not about passing or failing, but about assessing learning progress. At the classroom level it is one of a number of important tools used by teachers to measure student progress.
