**Assemblies will be every 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday afternoon at 2.30pm**

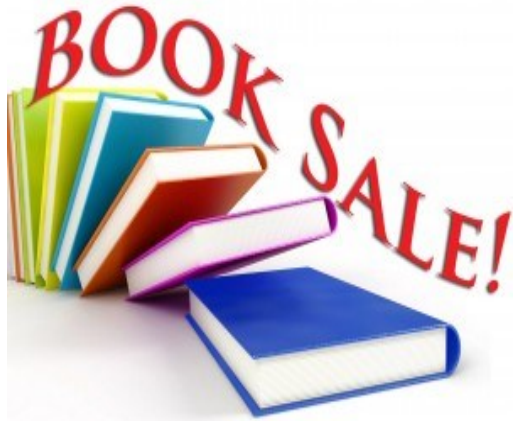
