If your child does not have a hat they will not be allowed to play – **NO HAT NO PLAY!**

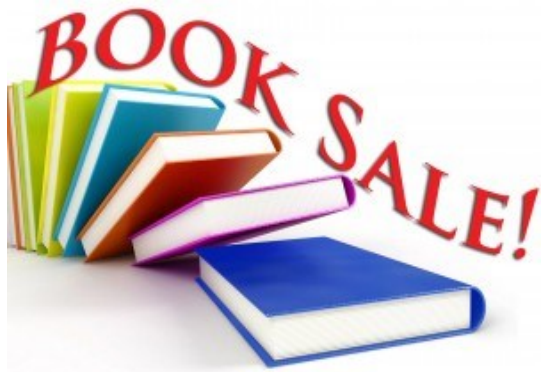
