Street Smart

The RAA will be working with all classes tomorrow to highlight the importance of road safety for our students. They help to teach children about road safety through the Street Smart Primary program by providing qualified and specially trained teachers to work with classes.

Road safety is most effectively learned when first-hand experiences of real life traffic situations are complemented by classroom and home activities. On their own, 'one off' traffic safety lessons are less effective in improving safe behaviour in the road environment, so the Street Smart Primary program will form part of their ongoing traffic safety education program both at home and at school.

Learning to use the road environment safely takes many years, and families and schools play an important role in saving children's lives and preventing injury.
