Sun Smart Message

Even though we are moving into the colder part of the season the UV levels can still be at dangerous levels. Students are required to wear hats all year round to ensure adequate protection from the sun no matter what season it is.

In saying this we also acknowledge the importance of safe exposure to UV for vitamin D which is essential for healthy bones and muscles and for general health.

As we are a Sun Smart school the UV levels are monitored daily. If the UV level is below 3 on school days a 'NO HAT' day is announced so students do not have to have hat protection. This decision is in line with the Cancer Councils recommendations.
