Uniforms

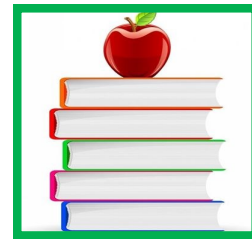
Reminder – Uniforms and hats are compulsory every day!
