

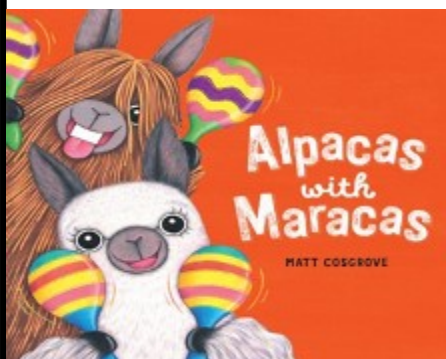

Uniforms

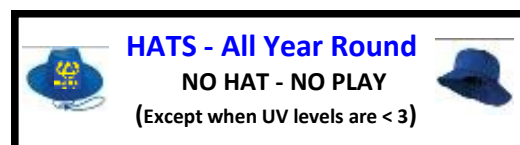

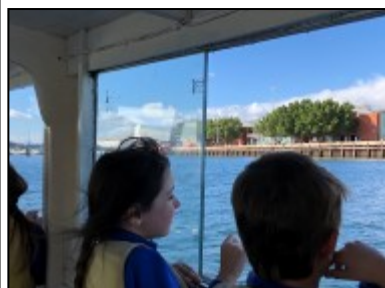
