Swimming is well underway in a somewhat chilly pool. At least the sun is shining and the temperatures are up. Students still need warm items of clothing for when out of the pool.

If your child has asthma can you please ensure appropriate medication is carried by them or brought into school for use. This includes spacers as they cannot be shared or used by others. Up to date medical plans are required for all students who have allergies and other health issues.

Fruit Snack Times

Every day around 10 am all classes have a fruit snack break. We promote healthy eating for our students and a nutritious mid- morning snack is important to provide the nutrients your child's growing body and brain needs. We ask that a piece of fruit/vegie stick/pieces be provided for your child for this mini snack.

Providing a bottle filled with **water** (not cordial or sugary drinks) is also essential for keeping hydrated, more importantly during the summer months.

We find that during our week of swimming lessons children become very hungry due to the energy they use in the pool. Please ensure that your child has an extra sandwich, cracker biscuits or fruit for this week.

Headlice

Head lice - including symptoms treatment and prevention

"Head lice are small wingless biting insects which live and breed in human hair and feed by sucking blood from the scalp.

Outbreaks of head lice are common in children in schools and institutions everywhere. They infest people of all socio-economic positions and age groups.

Spread is by direct head-to-head contact with a person who has head lice, or more rarely by contact with items which have been recently used by someone with head lice, such as:

- combs
- brushes
- hats
- scarves

The eggs usually hatch in 7 to 10 days.

Keeping Safe Curriculum

The Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum (KS:CPC) is a child safety program for children and young people from age 3 to year 12.

It teaches children to:

- recognise abuse and tell a trusted adult about it
- understand what is appropriate and inappropriate touching
- understand ways of keeping themselves safe.

The KS:CPC is mandated in all public preschools and schools and is taught every year by teachers who have completed a full day KS:CPC training course. It is a world-class, evidence-based child safety program that is used by a range of other Australian and international schools.

Please feel free to come in and check out what is available for your children to borrow and help them select some books to take home.



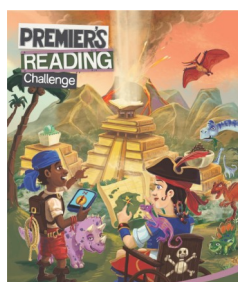
Wheelers eplatform
