Student Free Day

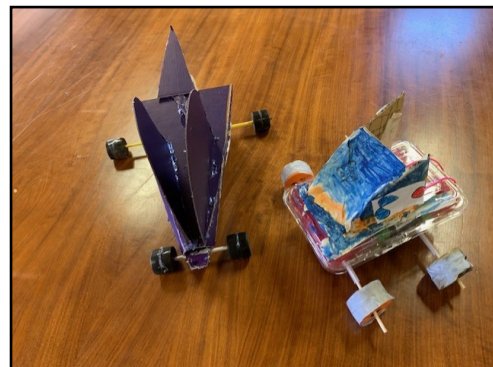
