*From the Principal*

Just a reminder that School opens at **8:45** for students, as staff are preparing for lessons before this time. Particularly as we head into the colder months there is no need for children to be getting to school earlier than this. A staff member is on duty from 8:45 to ensure safety and duty of care for all students on school grounds. We have a number of students who arrive regularly early, often before 8:30 and we are not always aware they are on the ground. For safety please have students arrive at the correct times.

We still have a few students who are not wearing school uniform as per our uniform policy. With colder weather a **plain** navy /dark warm top is acceptable. Tops with logo's or other designs are not.

Some food choices for children buying food on the way to school is not acceptable. Inappropriate items (blocks of chocolate, iced coffee and soft drinks) will be taken and returned at the end of the day. Please talk to your child who is buying lunch on the way to school about good food choices.

As part of our school device policy and in line with Departments policy, all mobile devices brought to school will be collected and stored at the front office until the end of the day.

No Student requires a phone during schools hours and if required students can go to the front office for parents to be contacted.

We should have results in term 3 where we can then reflect on student progress and continue our plan to further support students learning.
