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Library News...

Peterborough Primary School has subscribed to Wheelers eBooks Platform. This means all children at Peterborough Primary School and Yunta Campus have access to both our school library and now our eBook Library.

The advantages of eBook collection enable Staff, Students and Parents to borrow eBooks 24 hours a day seven days a week from any location. You do not need to physically visit the library to access our eBook collection. You can easily download to most smart devices including smartphones. You don't have to physically return the book.

Students are able to borrow 2 books for a 2 week period. When the loan has expired, the book will automatically return to the eBook lending platform.

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Select START BROWSING Scroll down and click to view your chosen title and bibliographic information. Select Sign In to read this title.

Students have been given their own Login details. If you would like details of your child's Log In details, please contact me at school on 8651 2102.

The Wheeler eBook interface will guide you on what to do next.
