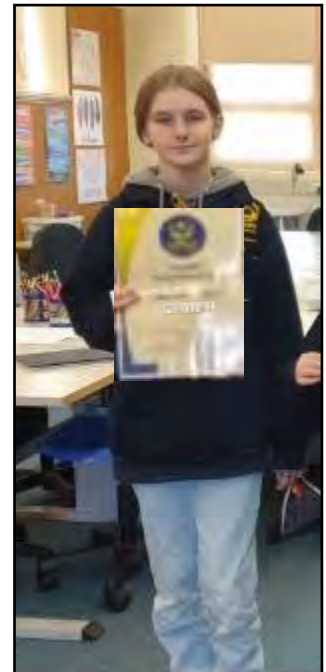

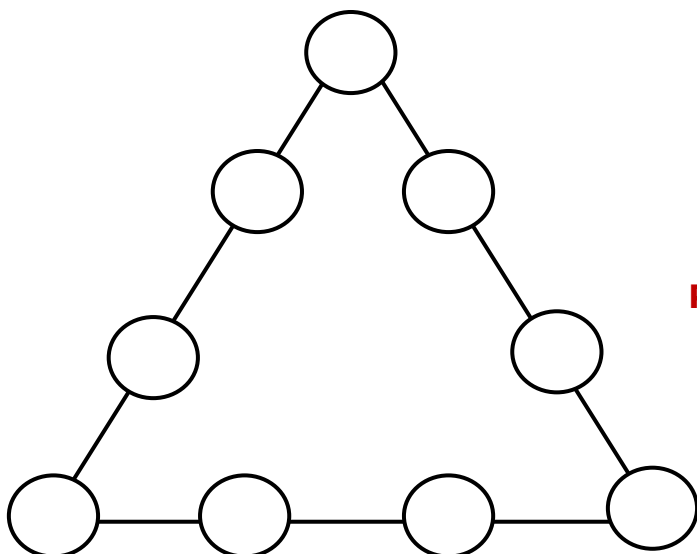
Congratulations, the Gowling/Gibson family who found 189 words.
